Chip will be in charge of the Fly-in food and needs a ticket count 3 to 4 days before the event. Marty has sent out publicity notices. Mike Brennan will make a phone call for the porta-potties. We need cans to hold raffle tickets in front of each item on the table.

Crow Island Airfield fly-in, Stow, MA 8/15/09, rain date 8/16.

Brendan Baldonado of Alpha One gave a presentation of the Sportcruiser LSA they will have for instruction and rental. It's a two passenger aircraft with a Rotax 912, 100hp using 91-93 octane auto fuel or 100LL (extra gear box cleaning necessary with 100LL). It will require a two-hour checkout and some ground school. \$85/hour wet, \$40 Instructor. Insurance carried by Alpha One is \$100,000 with a \$7,500 deductible so renters insurance is recommended. 4000rpm 100 kts 3 gph, 5000rpm 110 kts 5 gph, 30 gal capacity.

Mike Butts suggested bringing it to the fly-in for display with an Alpha One table and handouts.

The next meeting will be a hangar cleanup starting at 5 pm and an additional work party the preceding Sunday 8/16 at 2 pm.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:50.
