### CHIP'S TECH TALK

Making Changes. Many of us would like to make changes to their aircraft. As builders of experimental aircraft, we can do just about anything we want. This freedom to make changes is great but not usually wise to venture away from what the original designer intended. Sometimes we may have an un-certified aircraft that has been flying and we want to change things. Such as horizontal stabilizer fixed trim or wing strut adjustment to make the airplane "fly better". If changes are to be made, make very slight adjustments and test fly after each adjustment. Do not make several changes or adjustments at the same time. All of your testing should be done when the conditions are optimum.
