### Chip's Tech Talk

**There have been a couple of cases recently of unexplained engine problems. In both cases, scratches on the cylinder walls were found. Any scratches or score marks on piston skirts or cylinder walls is unacceptable. This condition indicates a problem that must be corrected. When you perform your Rotax annual inspection, the exhaust manifold must be removed. Once the manifold is removed, you will get a clear view of any potential trouble areas. You should also be looking for stuck rings when the manifold is removed.**
